2009 EHC HARVEST RESULTS

Around the world, thousands of believers responded to the call to help share the Good News by joining hands with Every Home for Christ in 2009.

In Africa, believers were mobilized to help share the Good News home to home across the continent. Churches in Togo, Benin, Liberia, Mali and a dozen other nations made special efforts to take the Gospel to isolated people groups where the Gospel has rarely, if ever, been heard.

Asia was another fertile harvest field. From Nepal to the Philippines, Christians joined forces to help share the Gospel with more than nine million people.

A new enthusiasm for evangel-

ism also swept through Latin America. Churches are uniting, just one Body of Christ doing God's work and teaching His Word.

For security reasons, reports from Creative Access nations (nations where worship and evangelism are restricted) must be kept confidential, but the impact of the Gospel on these nations has been tremendous.

Campaigns across Europe, the Pacific and the C.I.S. also contributed to a worldwide harvest of more than six million responses in 2009.

EHC President Dick Eastman said, "I'm convinced that as the Church units in prayer behind the spread of the Gos-

pel, we will witness an acceleration of the fulfillment of the Great Commission.

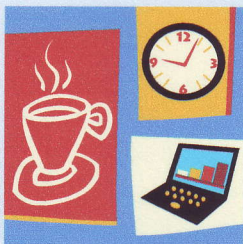
Our global network of intercessors will play a strategic role in the advancement of world evangelism in this generation."

MOBILE TRAINING CENTER (MTC)

Every Home for Christ serves local churches worldwide by training believers in evangelism and the mobilizing of congregations to systematically share the Gospel home to home, leaving printed gospel messages behind that can be read over and over again until Christ's offer of salvation becomes clear.

As people accept the Lord, EHC workers establish small fellowships called Christ Groups, often in the homes of new believers.

EHC's goal is to transform Christ Groups into self-sustaining churches, with leaders that have been trained and grounded in the Word of God.

Dick Eastman envisioned a mobile training program which could reach even the most remote regions.

The primary objective of the Mobile Training Center (MTC) program is preserving the harvest of EHC campaigns.

The MTC program at its core is based on training through a combination of video curriculum and a live instructor.

Each MTC unit consists of equipment for playing video training curriculum to groups. The EHC instructors will facilitate the discussion using points from the lessons as suggestions for the direction of the discussion.

The video will be used as a repeatable

format for the curriculum that can be used and reused in any context, even without the live EHC instructor present. It can also be used as a permanent resource for review or clarification after the mobile training unit has completed its training at a given location.

The live instruction is necessary to provide a mentoring element to the MTC program. The live instructors are to provide not only lessons of facts, figures and theories but also a listening ear and a caring heart. They will also have the potential of demonstrating the divine element by allowing the True Teacher be manifested through them.
