ADVANCE LEADERSHIP TRAINING, SINGAPORE

It was a time of refreshing from the Lord spending 25-days of just sitting under the ministry of God's Word. Our program started early in the morning at 7:00am-7:00pm in the evening.

There is more to do for the Kingdom of God, there no time to waste, the harvest is ripe (Jn 4:35b), but the workers are few.... "May those of us who are alive today make the last command of Jesus our first priority – The Great Commission (Matt 28:19)"

There were 31 participants from 21 nations who attended the Advanced Leadership Training and the course facilitators came from India, African Continent, South Korea, and Malaysia. The challenge from this training is to pass onto others in PNG what I have learnt, so please pray with me for God's direction.
