

PAAN PARTY

Paan (bread) and Parippu (dhal), the common man's favourite in Sri Lanka, today is beyond his reach. Hunger in Sri Lanka has become one of the worst tragedies in the history of a country where the rice production was surplus at one time! However, those who could and should take urgent remedial action have not yet decided to look at this situation with concern that it deserves.

Around 250,000 people are in need of food assistance in the northern Vanni region of Sri Lanka due to conflict and crop failure caused by flooding. People have been forced to flee their homes in the region since the upsurge in conflict between Sri Lankan army and the Tamil Tiger rebel movement.

Livelihoods have been almost completely lost, exacerbating the general food insecurity, and traditional coping mechanisms have been exhausted. People depend almost entirely on humanitarian food assistance for survival.

PAAN PARTY will support the NCEASL humanitarian assistance project in North of Sri Lanka. NCEASL anticipates PAAN PARTY will create awareness and solidarity among communities to support and share compassionately with the Displaced communities in Sri Lanka.
